Rt Hon. **Helen Clark**, 37th Prime Minister of New Zealand (from 1999 to 2008) and Administrator of the United Nations Development Programme from 2009 to 2017, was New Zealand's fifth-longest-serving Prime Minister, and the second woman to hold that office.

Forbes magazine ranked her the 22nd most powerful woman in the world in 2016.
